A hillside haven on Morocco's Atlantic coast

Set in a garden of palm trees and bougainvillea in the hills above Essaouira, Jardin des Douars has 25 rooms and suites, plus six villas with pools. The interiors feature North African textiles, pierced metalwork screens, Berber rugs, tadelakt plasterwork and zellige tiles. There are two jade green pools (one for families), two padel courts and a hammam, and a restaurant with menus influenced by Moroccan, French and Mediterranean cuisine.
