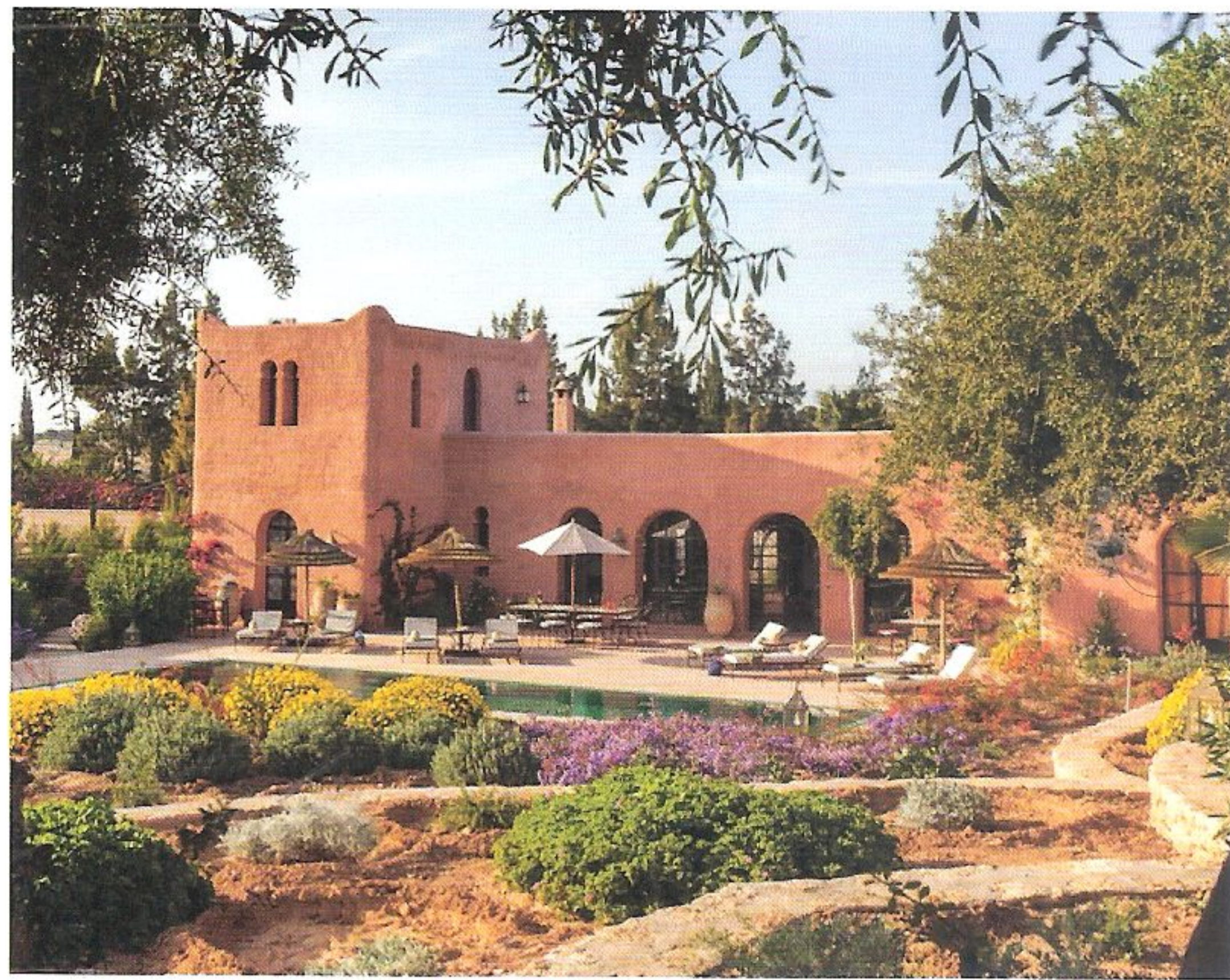

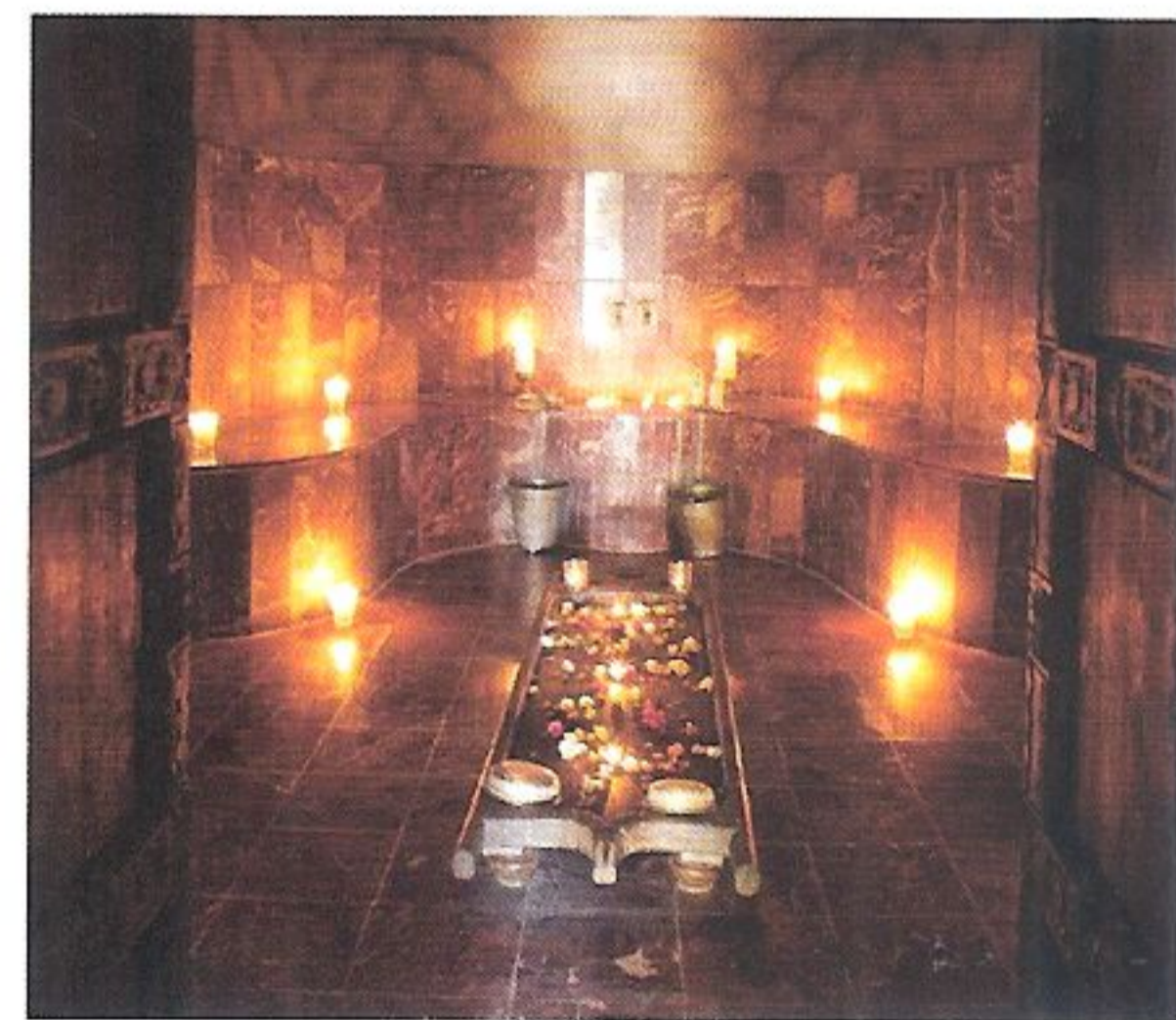
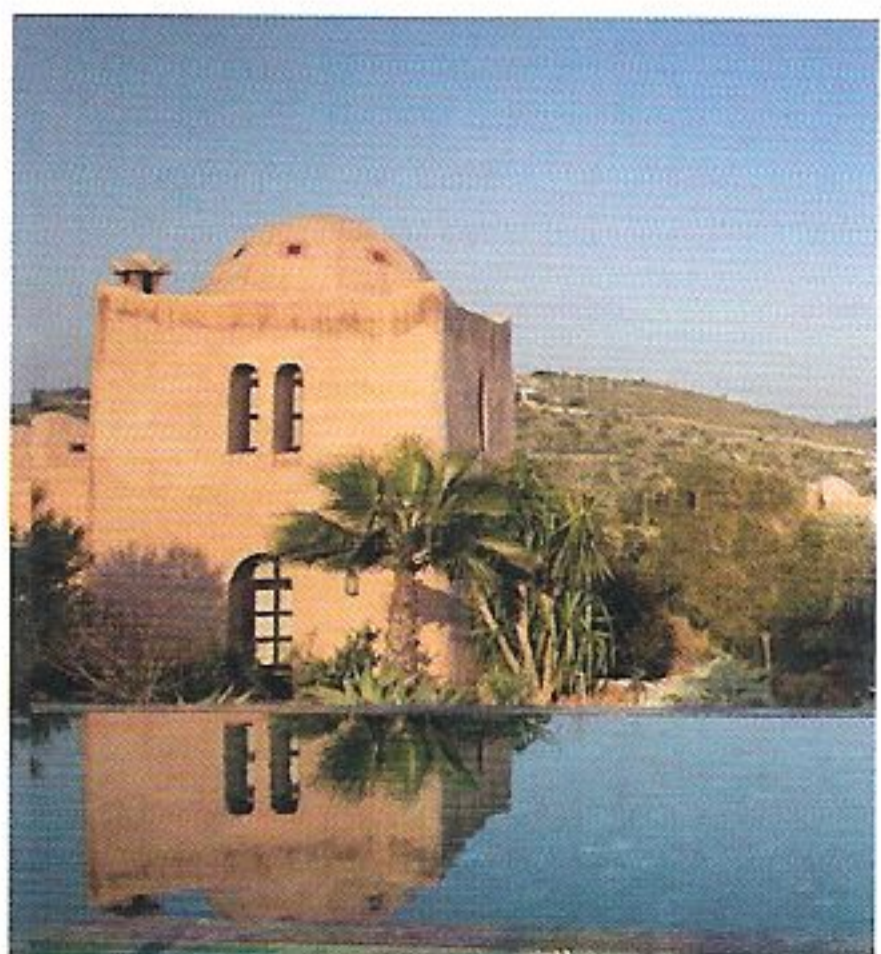


Best for Families LES JARDINS DES DOUARS

Venturing outside Marrakech we set off to the coast near Essaouira and discovered a favourite family retreat, Les Jardins des Douars, a beautiful Ksar (palace) surrounded by incredibly lush landscaped botanic gardens and terraces overlooking the Ksob River.

Protected from the notable winds of the area, Les Jardins des Douars provides the ideal getaway with two beautiful swimming pools (one dedicated to families and the other reserved as a quiet pool for adults), individual guesthouses built from traditional Moroccan materials and a simple yet stylish sense of interior design.

With shuttles on request to the nearby port of Essaouira, we enjoyed exploring the local culture and surrounding beaches before heading back to the tranquility of Les Jardins des Douars.



With the choice of two stunning pools, we spent a day swimming and relaxing in the protected terraces before heading to the spa. In the Hammam, the traditional warm rooms were dark and inviting with black marble interiors and treatments including an invigorating body scrub which consisted of being washed from head to toe and rinsed with buckets of tepid water while other spa treatments included a full choice of massage, luxury facials and body treatments. It was an opportunity not to be missed.

Having been scrubbed and massaged, the only thing left to do was relax with a cocktail on the terrace before enjoying a gourmet dinner. As the evening closed in, the sky overhead was dotted with a myriad of stars, every constellation visible.

It was the perfect end to our moment in Morocco, a hidden jewel in northern Africa and a place to return to at any opportunity.
